Founders Corner

Someone asked me to share my love story for the registered population, so here it is...

It starts when I was in my late teens/early 20s. I married a very abusive man. He was abusive in all ways (except he did not physically beat me). After 8 years, I divorced him. His ugliness continues to this day.

I tell you that background in order that you can see the incredible humor and power of our Lord!!

Fast forward 25 years and I'm working at Boeing. One of the project managers becomes my good friend. We eat together nearly every day, watch movies, or just hang out. I love him dearly and we are friends, then one day, he disappeared – just disappeared! He wasn't at work, he wasn't at his house, he wasn't anywhere that he was usually – I couldn't find him or find anyone that knew anything. I panicked!! One of our top managers saw my panic and took mercy on me. He pulled me aside and told me that Dean was alive, unhurt, and not sick. He couldn't tell me anything else. I continued for 2 years to look for Dean without any success.

One day Dean called me, he wouldn't tell me anything, but he stated that he was in trouble and had a big decision to make. He asked, "If you are accused of something you are not guilty of, do you accept a plea agreement?" In my total naiveté, I responded very strongly and with complete sincerity, "Of course not, our courts would find you innocent, if you are innocent." He said thank you and hung up. I told my daughter of our phone call and within moments she had found his court case...it was not good. A couple of weeks later, Dean's Dad called me and told me Dean had been sentenced to 20 years in prison. He said that Dean did not want any contact from me.

Of course, I'm not one to accept no, when I think I know better. I continued to call Dean's folks to get information about how he was doing and if I could visit him. Fast forward a couple more years and Dean's Mom told me that Dean would like for us to visit him. (I had married Steve) We visited nearly every week for about 8 years. Every time we were driving home, I would pray for Dean's health and safety. One day God interrupted me. He said, "I have thousands of men, just like Dean, calling out to me for help! I want you to help them." Then my brain exploded with His idea of what "help" looks like. Within less than a second God had given me Eagles' Nest. I turned to Steve and told him as much as I was able to express. We exited the freeway to look at a house that I remembered, and thought might fit the requirements God had given me. Steve bought in without a single objection.

There is much that has already happened that God put into my mind and heart that day and still much more to come! He is an amazing God – He heard your cries and prepared me from the beginning of my life to fulfill His plan to help His men. Men that He loves with all His heart. Steve and I ask God regularly to enable us to see and love you as He sees and loves you. HE SEES AND LOVES YOU IMMENSELY!!
