"Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises"


Prayer Requests


Hard to accept, I'll say it is, but once you accept it and accept Him, your life will change for the better and you will have His gift of Eternal Life with Him.

- Securus Customer Service 972-734-1111
- Write a letter to: Securus Technologies/ JPay Warehouse
- · Letter should include:
 - 1. State in letter you had a loner tablet, and you are requesting a USB of your media
 - 2. Copy of ID or License
 - 3. Current Phone #
 - 4. Complete Mailing Address (no P.O. boxes)
 - 5. State the Facility you were released from and the State
- Mail to:

The music will be downloaded to a USB, and it should be in the individuals' hands in about 45 business days. Individuals may call customer service after the 45 days to check on the USB status by calling the same number above
