


God is good & His provisions are all within your grasp. Only have faith & He will surely do it, no matter what it is. Faith in God means Faith in me and Faith in you. Rico M.




I attached myself to Jesus' yoke I found that indeed the burden is light! Jesus I trust in you! Brian C.




