"Free Falling"

You get a phone call, your daughter/mother/father/significant other has been involved in a terrible, life changing event and there is nothing you can do about it. You have worked for 30 years building something and are informed that it is not valuable to the company. You give your all to do your job to the best of your ability and are laid off. The doctor says you have cancer or have had a heart attack or diagnoses you with an incurable disease. All of these things can cause you to question – what is God doing? For me, it puts me in free falling mode.

Free falling is placing all your trust and faith in God. It's talking with God and talking with supportive others about what has happened and how it is affecting you – then releasing it to God. Resting in Him. Knowing without doubt that He loves you and is managing whatever it is that has caused you to feel out of control. Free falling is resting in God during upsetting and or life changing events – events outside of your control.

Why do we have the luxury of free fall?

Philippians 4:6-9 **"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
