Kay had many careers in her lifetime, from being a business owner twice to driving a UPS truck. Kay was a member of the Silver Bell Widows Group.


She was loved by many and will be sadly missed by all.

I've finished my paid time off and started retirement 3 days ago. It's taking a bit of adjustment and I keep thinking I need to get everything done, so I can go back to work.

We're making progress on the small business co-op. I think we will name it Aeries Small Business Coop. We got the business phone yesterday and Richard G is the first business owner!

I got to spend 2 days with Jimmy P (Keys) while he continued his treatment. The time passed very quickly and I really enjoyed hearing about his experiences inside and his perspective in going through this cancer experience. He has quite a testimony!! It was also interesting to hear his questions and be able to share.

Update on Jimmy from Wednesday:

Jimmy asked me to share,

- 1. His white count was good, the doctor was very happy about that.
- 2. His lack of pain is amazing the doctors.
- 3. His tumors have shrunk by about half size. He has a full jawline now!
- 4. He had lost weight, down to 172 from 190. Yesterday he had gained up to 176. Yesterday and today he was able to eat. We ate a lot and today he weighed 183.
- 5. His vitals are all good.

He has been praising God and writing songs.

That's the good news. Please pray those continue. We spent the last two days getting chemo and radiation.

Thursday the hiccups and and the nausea started again. They added another medication to his prescriptions to help with the nausea. Please pray he continues to do well and spiritually and emotionally remains healthy.

Latest update from Sunday:

The vomiting has been worse and his weight is down into the 160's. He is feeling God's love and support very strongly. The nausea should go away within the next few days.

L.E.D.

But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor."

(Joh 12:23-26)

The writer captures a pressing line of monologue, a powerful and potent statement that challenges the heart of anybody who will allow themselves to truthfully examine it. "If anyone serves Me, let him FOLLOW me".

It is one thing to claim to be Christian, many do. However, to fully embrace Christ and surrender all in service to Him requires a level of commitment that is cost intensive but rewarding beyond measure. The first step in this life is to surrender and be L.E.D.

L.E.D. is to have a **Life Eternally Directed**. To follow, in the Greek, means: "to follow one who precedes, join him as his attendant, accompany him". This signifies that following is purposefully traveling along with Christ, with a surrendered will and with an attitude of service, as the shepherd leads. The Bible warns, in Amos 3:3, Can two walk together, unless they are agreed? The battle for many of us is to agree and desire to follow instead of being uncertain and following out of obligation.

L.E.D. is to be **Loosed Embracing Destiny**. We know the Shepherd leads His sheep, now free and liberated from sin and slavery, in a purposeful direction. The test and trials help us to see our weakness and His strength perfected IN our weakness. As we give all to Him, we gain the understanding that our limits are no longer determined by our abilities but in His sovereignty. We discover that there IS a purpose to our existence and a tailored plan for our lives. We rest in the knowledge that we are not just redeemed; we are abundantly loved and lavishly graced sons and daughters of God.

L.E.D. is to become a **Light Expelling Darkness**. As yielded vessels for the master's desire, we become conduits for our Father's will to be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. We are soldiers fighting darkness and deception with the light above all lights and the unchanging truth of the Father. To His called we declare His love, to His enemies we proclaim His dominion.

Now that he is Loosed Embracing Destiny, he has Left Everlasting Destruction and is Letting
