Applying to be a Resident at Eagles' Nest

Additions to our Application Process

Effective immediately our policy regarding the time frame to apply for residence at Eagles' Nest is as follows:

- We will process applications only when the applicant is within 24 months of their release date.
- We recommend an individual apply as early as possible after the 24 month window.
- If a person is outside the 24 month window but has a desire to apply to Eagles' Nest or is just interested in the ministry, we are willing to communicate with him and develop a relationship over time. This can be done by mail or tablet. Our goal is to get to know an individual as much as possible and them to get to know us prior to their coming home to Eagles' Nest. This is essential to Christian family atmosphere here at Eagles' Nest.

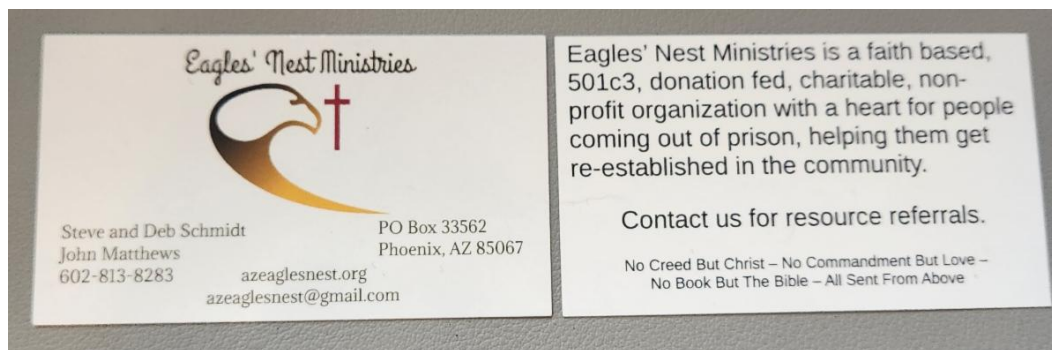

Current Needs Where Help is Needed

Surplus Purchasing

In order to qualify to be able to purchase from the Arizona State Agency for Surplus Property when things we need become available like vehicles, Conex storage containers, etc., the application requires us to provide a letter from a public official certifying that those receiving services are primarily homeless or impoverished. We are having a situation finding someone who will do this. If you know of a public official who will provide us a short letter signifying we serve people who would be homeless and who are impoverished as they come out of prison, please put us in touch with them.
