It is often inexplicable – found in His people at the oddest of times and under terrible circumstances! Acts 13:52 "And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."

James instructs us to "be joyful in trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have: its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing." (James 1:2-8)

2 Corinthians 8:1-2 "Moreover, brethren, we make known to you the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia: that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality."

## Practical Living from the Word of God

What is your Isaac?

There is a well-known, and often difficult to read story in Genesis 22. Abraham, the father of faith for both Jews and Christians, is asked by God to sacrifice his son Issac on top of a specific mountain. Taking the life of another human is not a practice given to man in his worship of God, however Abraham knew God and followed him at His word.

Issac, the one to be sacrificed, is the promised son that Abraham and his wife Sarah had long waited for. When the couple tried to "help" God accomplish the promise seeing that old age made it seemingly impossible to achieve, it ended up in disaster. Through their experiences, they learned to let God fulfill His word on His terms.

The story is one of Abraham and Issac's trust and obedience, as well as God's provision. (Interestingly, the word "provision" comes from the Latin word providere 'foresee, attend to'.) Abraham, trusting God that there was a purpose behind this, and Issac trusting both His father and the God they served, went up the mountain to obey God's command. There they experienced God in such a way that the name He was given by Abraham is one we call on even today. I would recommend you stop and read the story before continuing if you are unfamiliar with it, as there will be spoilers ahead.

God stopped the process seeing Abraham's dedication and faith. Verse 12 reads "And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for **now I know that you fear God**, **since you have not withheld your son**, your only son, from Me." Abraham's faith was proven in that ANYTHING he had, no matter how irreplaceable, could be sacrificed in order to obey God's word.

#### Anything.

Think about it. For Abraham, nothing was too valuable that he couldn't release it to God to obey His word. Ur, his homeland. Lot, his cousin. Hagar and Ishmael, the son of his attempt at "helping" God. Isaac, the son he was meant to have. All of these he had, or was willing to, let go of to keep God's word. Abraham's example of trusting in God is hard to fathom and challenges our "modern" faith standards.

Would God ever challenge us in such a way? Well, there is no scripture precedent to take one of our beloved kids up a mountain to sacrifice to God, (nor are we to take the less beloved either). But Jesus does challenge us. It is written; "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it." (Mat 10:37-39)

Not only does this challenge us to put Jesus above our family, but it also includes the thing we often hold most dear, our very lives. I know the struggle; we often feel as if we are beginning to understand ourselves and experience life on our terms when the word of God comes to tell us to sacrifice our lives (living sacrifice). A friend, Christopher K., once told me during my struggles to be a more effective minister, that I needed to learn how to die. That was well over a decade ago, and I still revisit it to this day.

What comforts me about this story, is God's response to Abraham's obedience. He provided a ram to replace Issac for sacrifice. Abraham had to "lift up his eyes" to see the ram, which always reminds me that there is much more going on around me. I need to remember to look up from what I am IN to see where I am AT! We can get caught up in the toughness of what we are called to lay down for the kingdom, but looking up reveals just how much God has going on in the kingdom that hinges upon our obedience. A reminder that we are attached to something much greater and deeply interconnected. Abraham's demonstration of faith was, initially, displayed between himself, Issac and God. However, the story of it has affected and encouraged countless others throughout history.

Another saint I met in my journeys, a chaplain's clerk named Manny, often asked what is my Issac. Truth be told, I hated that question. "What thing do I hold dear that I will have to give up to serve God", haunted my thoughts for years.

However, now I realize that was an incomplete response to the question. Maturity has taught me, "what thing do I hold dear that God is asking for, that proves my fear of Him and blesses those around me."

The Word of God says in Proverbs 16:9 NLT -"We can make our plans, but the LORD determines our steps."




