James 4:7, "Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. first Peter 5:8-9


Founder's Corner

There are MANY types of men – some are kind and generous, some are vile and hateful, some are quiet and thoughtful, some are noisy, some are excitable, some are quite reserved...you probably can think of many other types of men, but there are only three types of men as it relates to God.

There's a man that denies the existence of God. This man may think he has it all together and doesn't need the crutch of believing in God. He may think that God is just plain nonsense made up by a bunch of well meaning (or evil) people. He may think any number of thoughts that he thinks are reasonable. The Bible says, not believing in God is foolish and leads to death. **Proverbs 14:12**, "There is a way *that seems* right to a man, but its end *is* the way of death." **Psalm 14:1**, "The fool has said in his heart, *there is* no God."

There's a man that acknowledges there is a God. This man believes that God makes sense. He can see the wonderful and miraculous thing surrounding him and can't deny that God exists. He may see the terrible things happening in this world, he may not understand the hurtful and damaging things that he believes God has allowed to happen to him. He may feel that he is doing just fine without God. He doesn't need God although he believes He exists. The Bible says, even the demons believe in God. James 2:19, "You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!"

There's a man the acknowledges there is a God and chooses to make Him Lord of his life. This man understands that he is unable to ever pay for the choices he has made in his life. He realizes that God not only exists, but that He loves him and sacrificed greatly to allow him to have a relationship with Him. He knows that God has thoughts far above his thoughts and plans far above his plans. He submits his will and thoughts to God's control. The Importance of Tithing: A Biblical Perspective

Tithing is like sowing seeds in a fertile garden, rooted in biblical teachings that emphasize the importance of returning to God a portion of what He has generously provided. The concept of a "tithe" means a tenth,

- Old Testament: The principle of tithing is established in the Old Testament, Leviticus 27:30 states, "A tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the Lord; it is holy to the Lord." This is akin to a farmer setting aside the first fruits of his
- New Testament: While the New Testament does not specify a percentage, it emphasizes the spirit of generosity and cheerful giving. 2 Corinthians 9:7 says, "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." Imagine giving as a flowing river, abundant and life-giving, rather than a stagnant pool.
- Supporting the Church: Tithes are like the bricks and mortar that maintain the church building, support pastoral staff, and fund various ministries. Malachi 3:10 encourages believers to bring the
- Worship Team: The music provided by our church band is like the heartbeat of our worship services, uplifting and uniting us in praise. Your contributions help sustain this vital ministry,

A common question in tithing discussions is whether to tithe on gross income (before taxes) or net

- Gross Income: Tithing on gross income reflects the belief that we give back to God from the first fruits of our labor, acknowledging that everything we earn is a blessing from Him. Proverbs 3:9 states, "Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the first fruits of all your crops." It's like offering the first and best potatoes or watermelons from a garden, recognizing the source of the harvest.
- Net Income: Others choose to tithe on net income, considering it the actual amount available after taxes and necessary deductions. This approach can still honor God and support the church while being mindful of personal financial responsibilities. It's like budgeting wisely to ensure all needs are met while still giving generously.

Ultimately, the decision should be made prayerfully and with a heart of generosity. The key is togive cheerfully and willingly, as God values the spirit of our giving more than the specific amount.
